# ANDREWS FAMILY PAPERS 1824-1917

#### INTRODUCTION

The Andrews Family Papers, 1824-1917, primarily relate to the family of Ephraim Andrews (1796-18340, his sons, George Andrews (1800-ca. 1862), Mark Montgomery Andrews (1804-1890), and Stith Hardaway Andrews (1809-1855), and his grandson, Thomas McDonough Andrews (1841-1921), a Nashville attorney.

The collection occupies .42 linear feet of shelf space and numbers approximately 200 items. There are no restrictions on the collection and single photocopies of unpublished writings may be may for purposes of individual or scholarly research.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Andrews Family Papers, 1824-1917, approximately 200 items, is composed of accounts, estate papers, legal documents and correspondence. There are estate papers for Ephraim Andrews (1769-1834), and his wife, Ann Hardaway (Locke) Andrews, (1779-1864), and accounts for Ephraim's sons, Mark Montgomery Andrews (1804-1890), George Andrews (1800-ca. 1862), and Stith Hardaway Andrews (1809-1855). The correspondence is primarily that of Thomas McDonough Andrews (1841-1921), a Nashville attorney. Also included are some school accounts ad a list of pupils in the Williamson County District School, taught by S. A. Jefferson for 1845 and 1846.
