INTRODUCTION

This finding aid focuses on the papers of Irl Ramon Barker, accountant and genealogist, born in Benton County, Tennessee. Spanning the years 1904-1994, although the bulk is largely centered between 1937-1987, the papers contain considerable genealogical data on the Barker and Utley families, supplemented with many photographs and negatives. Also contained in the collection are materials relating to Irl Barker and his activities with the Nashville, Chattanooga and St. Louis railway. Other items within the collection include clippings, correspondence, legal documents, and obituaries. The materials were donated by Mrs. Elsie U. Barker, the wife of the late Irl R. Barker.

The materials in the collection originally measured 14.0 cubic feet, but was reduced to 7.0 cubic feet by the removal of numerous financial documents (bills and receipts) and other extraneous materials. There are no restrictions on the materials. Single photocopies of unpublished writings in the Irl R. Baker Papers may be made for individual or scholarly research.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Irl Ramon Barker Papers, containing approximately 1200 items, span the period 1904-1994, although the bulk is largely centered in the years 1937-1987. The collection is composed of cemetery records, church records, clippings, correspondence, genealogical data, legal documents, railroad records, obituaries, photographs, and negatives.

A major portion of the collection consists of correspondence and genealogical data. Correspondence has been arranged into two categories: family and general. The genealogical data relates to the Barker and Utley families and related lines.

Supplementing the genealogical information are numerous photographs and negatives, most of which relate to the Barker family and their descendants of Benton County, Tennessee.

Mr. Barker was employed as an accountant with the Nashville, Chattanooga and St. Louis railway for sixteen years. Reflecting his activities and interest in this railroad are photographs and negatives picturing various activities. Also included are newsletters and correspondence concerning ex-employees' annual meetings.

Among the newspaper clippings is an interesting account of a trial of three Chicago men charged with the biggest robbery in the annals of crime, \$100,000 in unset diamonds. Mr. Barker, as a juror in this trial, not only saved newspapers accounts of the trial, but also recorded his daily recollections in a small notebook (see Box 1, Folder 19).

- 1938-1940 Odd jobs.
- 1940-1942 Auditor, bookkeeper and office manager with E. Gray Smith, Packard Automobile dealer, Nashville, Tennessee.
- 1942-1958 Accountant with N. C. & St. L. railway.
- 1958-1964 Accountant/auditor in Public Works Department, Nashville, Tennessee.
- 1965-1972 Manager of Belle Meade Tower Apartments.
- 1979 _____ married Elsie Utley Powell.
- 1985 Removed to Tuscaloosa, Alabama.
- 1994 November 18, died at his home in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, and interred at Woodlawn Cemetery in Nashville, Tennessee.
