## INTRODUCTION

The Booker Family Papers, consisting of three cubic feet, spans the years 1950 through 1987. The collection is genealogical in nature, and is centered around the research of Lucy (Thomas) Booker, a local historian and genealogist of Maury County, Tennessee. Her primary interests were her family, the Thomas and Clark families of Christian and Trigg Counties, Kentucky, and Maury County, Tennessee, as well as inter-related families. The Thomas and Clark families were originally from North Carolina and settled in southwestern Kentucky in the early nineteenth century.

The papers include correspondence, notes, notebooks, printed materials, records and sketches, all reflective of the genealogical interests of Mrs. Booker. The collection arrived in several boxes, along with numerous large notebooks. The collection was arranged in no particular order. These materials were initially loaned to the Tennessee State Library and Archives for microfilming by Dr. Sue Loper of Columbia State Community College, and later after filming, were donated. There are no restrictions on the material. Single photocopies of items in the Booker Family Papers may be made for genealogical or scholarly research.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Booker Family Papers, consisting of approximately three cubic feet, spans the period 1950 through 1987. The collection consists of original and photocopied materials pertaining to the genealogical interests of Lucy (Thomas) Booker. Items within the collection are arranged alphabetically by subject and include applications, certificates, correspondence, notebooks, notes, photographs, printed materials, sketches and other miscellaneous items.

The bulk of the collection consists of notebooks created by Mrs. Booker. The notebooks were presented to family members as gifts and provide a genealogical history of that particular family. Although there may be some overlapping of information, the processor attempted to retain the original order of each notebook. The researcher should be aware that the notebooks may contain information on more than one family. Within each notebook are genealogical tables and charts, photocopies of marriage, birth and death records, as well as copies of deeds and wills.

The notes are the materials gathered by Mrs. Booker for the completion of the family notebooks. The notes range from photocopies to short notes written on paper bags. Also included are the supporting papers gathered for Mrs. Booker's Revolutionary War ancestors. The supporting papers were used as evidence for entrance into the Daughter's of the American Revolution. Mrs. Booker spent many years as a volunteer at the Polk Home in Columbia, Tennessee, and there are several files concerning Polk genealogy and the Polk home.

Other materials in the collection are of lesser importance, but include several miscellaneous photographs of family members, a small amount of correspondence, and a random selection of newsletters from various historical and genealogical societies.
