# BRYANT, OLEN LITTLETON PAPERS 1961-1992

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### **INTRODUCTION**

The Olen Littleton Bryant Papers (1961-1992) are centered around the artistic and teaching career of Olen Littleton Bryant, Clarksville, Tennessee. The Bryant Papers were donated to the Tennessee State Library and Archives by his close friend, Vanderbilt faculty member and art critic, Thomas B. Brumbaugh. The collection occupies 1.89 cubic feet and numbers approximately 1350 items.

Single photocopies of unpublished writings in the Olen Littleton Bryant Papers may be made for scholarly research.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Olen Littleton Bryant Papers, containing ca. 1350 items, span the period 1961-1992. The collection is composed of advertisements, an agenda, a card, clippings, correspondence, financial documents, genealogical data, horoscopes, interviews, invitations, programs, etc., memoranda, obituaries, poetry, photographs, drawings, etc., publications, a recommendation, a report, sketches, and writings.

The bulk of the collection is comprised of sketch-laden correspondence and numerous clippings generated by artist/sculptor/educator Olen Littleton Bryant, born in Cookeville, Tennessee in 1927. Bryant graduated from Lebanon High School in 1946 and received his undergraduate education from Murray State College (presently known as Murray State University) in Murray, Kentucky. He earned his Master of Fine Arts degree at the Cranbrook Academy of Art in Bloomfield Hills, Michigan. He has also studied at other institutions throughout Europe and North and Central America.

While known primarily for his works as a sculptor, Bryant is recognized as an excellent educator, having taught in secondary and post-secondary institutions, including Cumberland University, Union University, and Emory University. He is currently Professor Emeritus of Art at Austin Peay State University.

The majority of correspondence consists of Bryant's communication with close friend Thomas B. Brumbaugh, art critic and faculty member at Vanderbilt University. In most cases, Bryant's correspondence was typed or handwritten on the back of correspondence sent to him. Many times this included correspondence from U.S. Representatives and Senators from Tennessee. The clippings contain mainly newspaper and magazine reviews of art exhibits in which Bryant participated. Also included are art and theatre reviews written by Bryant.

Within the collection are several biographical sketches of Bryant, as well as sketches of artists: Meyer Wolfe (1897-1985) and Edwin B. Johnson (1904-1968). Also included is a biographical sketch of Elizabeth Meriwether Gilmer (1861-1951); advice columnist, commonly known by her pen name "Dorothy Dix." There also exists within the collection genealogical data and clippings related to Gilmer.

Among the publications is a catalog detailing the biographical history of African-American sculptor William Edmondson of Nashville (1883?-1951); and a publication listing photographs and documentation of some of Nashville's nineteenth century skyline architecture. These items were microfilmed and removed to the Library collection.

See clippings, biographical sketches, and interviews for valuable insight into the educational background, accolades, and humorous elements connected to the artistic philosophy of Olen L. Bryant.
