INTRODUCTION

The Helen Bullard Collection, 1910-[1963-1977]-1977, is centered around research done for a book, Craftsman of the Tennessee Mountains. The Helen Bullard Collection is a gift of Ms. Helen Bullard, Ozone, Tennessee.

The collection occupies 1.26 cubic feet of shelf space, and numbers approximately 500 items. Single photocopies of unpublished writings in the Helen Bullard Collection may be made or purposes of scholarly research.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Helen Bullard Collection spans the period 1910-1977, though the bulk is concentrated in the years 1963-1977. The collection consists of agendas, a biographical sketch, brochures, cards, correspondence, a grant proposal, a handbook, an invitation, lists, a manual, minutes, newsletters, newspaper clippings, notes, printed materials, and subject files.

Many of the items in this collection are a part of the research done by Helen Bullard while writing her book, Craftsmen of the Tennessee Mountains. The collection covers a wide range of handicraft work, offering insight into the craftsmen involved, and giving insight into the amount of precise detail that must be kept when displaying handicraft work at various shows nationwide. The collection is centered on the Southeastern United States.

While processing this collection, the original order of the collection was retained as much as possible, providing very easy access to the various facets covered in the research. The Subject Files in box 3 were also left as they were found because they refer to the chapters included in Ms. Bullard's book. In the Subject Files one can find a variety of documents, including brochures, correspondence, and newspaper clippings, all directly relating to the specific subject.
