INTRODUCTION

This finding aid focuses on the papers of Joyce Bradley McComb, genealogist, born in White County, Tennessee. Spanning the years 1778-1991, although the bulk is largely concentrated between 1981-1988, the papers contain genealogical information collected by Mrs. McComb on her following family lines: Beam, Bohannon, Bradley, Broyles, England, Geer, Goodbread, Hargis, Horn, Hunter, Johnson, Laird, Ledbetter, Norton, Officer, Snodgrass, Stamps, Vaughn, Wallace, and Williams.

The materials were donated by Joyce Bradley McComb, the compiler, of Lexington, South Carolina. A small addition, containing similar genealogical data was donated in 2004, and was processed into the collection.

The collection in this finding aid measures 2.5 linear feet. There are no restrictions on the materials. Single photocopies of unpublished writings in the Joyce Bradley McComb Collection may be made for individual or scholarly research.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Joyce Bradley McComb Collection, containing approximately 2,500 items, span the period 1778-1991, although the bulk is concentrated between 1981-1988. The collection is composed of genealogical information compiled by Mrs. McComb on her ancestral family lines.

The collection consists of numerous correspondence and family history charts, with copies of supporting documents of census, court, land, military, and pension records which substantiate the genealogical findings of the compiler.

The Joyce Bradley McComb Collection provides important genealogical data on several early families in White County, Tennessee.
