## **INTRODUCTION**

The Norvell Sevier Rose Collection (1846 – ca. 1930) contains the recipe books of Norvell Sevier Rose ( - fl. 1930), a Nashvillian and descendant of John Sevier. Some of the recipe books also contain interesting household health and home remedies. The Norvell Sevier Rose Collection was donated to the Tennessee State Library and Archives by Ms. Bernice (Bernie) Arnold of Nashville, Tennessee.
