Scope & Content:

Minutes from seventy-seven meetings of the Signal Mountain Community Guild spanning the years 2000 through 2014. Notes include items such as treasurer's reports, reports of the Guild's activities, and making plans for future events. One of the most discussed events in the annual Dogwood Luncheon held on the last Wednesday of April each year to celebrate the Woman of the Year. Recording the proceedings of the meetings not only shows the Guild members' general interests and activities but also those of the Signal Mountain region. They could also be helpful in studying modern social history and charitable giving organizations.

The Signal Mountain Community Guild, Inc. is a women's civic and social welfare service organization in Signal Mountain, Tennessee. It was founded in 1928 and is the oldest established community group in the area. There are monthly meetings at the town hall where members hear from guest speakers on local topics of interest. The guild meets from September through May each year. Some of its current activities include naming a Signal Mountain Woman of the Year at its annual Dogwood Luncheon, publishing a biennial phone directory, hosting a book club and, offering a Community Craft Night. They also offer charitable support to the Mountain Arts Community Center, Bachman Community Center, Walden Ridge Emergency Service, Signal Mountain Public Library and, Signal Mountain Social Services, among others.
