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## INTRODUCTION

This finding aid focuses on the Tennessee College Association (T.C.A.) Records, 1920-1999. The Tennessee College Association was organized on December 23, 1919 at Chattanooga, Tennessee, with the stated objective of “advancing the cause of higher education through the promotion of interests common to the colleges of Tennessee.” Membership is open to all public and private junior and four-year colleges and universities in the state. In January 1964 the Tennessee College Association Center for Higher Education was established for the purposes of: “1) promoting cooperation and planning of the participating institutions toward the most effective use of their educational facilities, personnel, and other resources; 2) to serve as a central source of information; and 3) to conduct surveys, studies, and research in higher education on behalf of the participating institution.”

The collection largely consists of correspondence and minutes of the proceedings of annual meetings of the T. C. A.

The materials in this finding aid measures six cubic feet. There are no restrictions on the materials. Single photocopies of unpublished writings in the Tennessee College Association Records may be made for scholarly research.

## **SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

The Tennessee College Association Records, containing approximately 1200 items, span the period 1920-1929. The collection is composed of correspondence, minutes, publications, reports, surveys, and several miscellaneous items.

The collection is largely composed of correspondence and minutes of proceedings of annual meetings of the T.C.A. Correspondence has been arranged chronologically into two categories: general and a self-survey of Tennessee colleges. General correspondence includes annual meetings, applications for membership, dues payments, committee reports, etc. The self-survey of Tennessee colleges, undertaken between 1924-1928, and conducted by the U. S. Bureau of Education, was used to classify the higher education institutions in Tennessee as well of making recommendations for membership in the T. C. A. One of the results of this self-survey was a report published in 1924. A draft copy of the report may be found in Box 12, Folder 9.

The minutes of the proceedings of the annual meetings have been arranged separately according to year. There is a complete file on their meetings between 1919 and 1999 except for the years 1919, 1920, 1944, and 1945. A separate file has been arranged for the minutes of the executive committee. Materials related to these proceedings may be found in the general correspondence files.
