## INTRODUCTION

This finding aid focuses on the records of the L.C. Tiller Piano Company of Nashville, Tennessee. The collection is composed of agreements, certificates, correspondence, financial statements, photographs, account and payment books and several miscellaneous items. Although the company was founded in 1917, the bulk of the collection is concentrated from the 1930s through the 1960s.

The L.C. Tiller Piano Company was founded in 1917 by Lee Carter Tiller (1894-1967). Tiller, a native of Louisville, Kentucky, had been trained in the music business by his father, F.M. Tiller, before arriving in Nashville in 1917. In the early years the office and showroom was located at 206 Capitol Boulevard in the old Joseph Frank building (now the office of Work and Greer, Public Accountants). In the mid-1930s, Tiller moved his business to 123 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, North where it remained until its closure. In 1946, Tiller's son-in-law, Edward D. Null (1921-2000) joined the firm. Null continued to operate the business after Tiller's death in 1967. When Null retired in 1992, the firm was closed.

The collection was presented to the Tennessee Historical Society in 1996 by Roy Barbee, Nashville, Tennessee. There are no restrictions on the material. Single photocopies of unpublished materials in the L.C. Tiller Piano Company Papers may be made for individual or scholarly research. Usage of any photographic materials and documents in this collection should include reference to the Tennessee Historical Society, Nashville, Tennessee.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The L.C. Tiller Piano Company Papers, containing .5 cubic feet of material, 1 oversized box and 41 volumes, span the period 1919 through 1967, although the bulk of the material is concentrated between 1929 through 1967. The collection is composed of agreements, certificates, correspondence, financial statements, income tax returns, photographs, printed materials and account and payment books. There is very little correspondence or other loose papers in the collection.

The account books are the records of the day-to-day operations of the company. Beginning in 1927 and continuing through 1969, the account books list monies received, account debits, payrolls, insurance payments and other company expenditures. The payment books are the payment records of those who bought or leased pianos or other appliances from the company and date from 1929 through 1968. Apart from the schedule of payments made by the customer, each entry may include an address, employment history, and names of relatives. In future years, the payment books may prove to be genealogical significant for the amount of information provided. There are several interesting photographs in the collection including the noted operatic singer, Marie Morrisey and the famed "torch singer" Ruth Etting.

The L.C. Tiller Piano Company was one of Nashville's oldest piano and music dealerships. Although a small collection, the L.C. Tiller Piano Company Papers will prove to be a significant addition to the economic history of Nashville.
