INTRODUCTION

The Edyth Rucker Whitley Scrapbook Collection, consisting of scrapbooks of newspaper items of the First World War and clippings concerning Tennesseans who served in the Second World War and Korean War, was compiled by Edyth Rucker Whitley (1900-1989) of Nashville, Tennessee. The donor is Edyth Rucker Whitley.

The collection occupies 1.68 cubic feet of shelf space, and numbers approximately 531 items. Single photocopies of unpublished material in the Edyth Rucker Whitley Scrapbook Collection may be made for purposes of scholarly research.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Edythe Rucker Whitley Scrapbook Collection, consisting of 531 items, spans the periods of 1916-1917, 1940-1945, and 1953. The collection consists of newspaper clippings, the majority of which relate to World War II.

These clippings concern Tennesseans who were inducted into military service, their promotions and transfers, casualty lists, and those killed or missing in action. In addition to clippings of World War II, there are news items relating to World War I and the Korean War.
