**SCOPE AND CONTENT**

The Enumeration of Male Inhabitants of the State of Tennessee was conducted during the first three months of the year 1891. The even was instigated by an Act of the General Assembly of Tennessee, passed January 15, 1891. Chapter 22 of the Acts of 1891 states,

“the Governor of the State shall, as soon as this Act becomes law, appoint one or more suitable persons from each county of the State, upon the recommendation of Senators and Representatives of the respective counties in this General Assembly, to be known as commissioners, whose duty it shall be to take and make out in writing an accurate and complete list of all the male inhabitants of their respective counties who are twenty-one years of age and upward, who shall have been resident citizens of their respective counties on the first day of January, 1891, and it shall be the duty of each commissioner to return such list of male inhabitants so taken by them, as aforesaid, certified to the Clerk of the County Court of their respective counties within twenty days from the first day of February, 1891.

All Tennessee counties are available, except for the counties of Bledsoe, Campbell, Perry, and Sequatchie.
