SCOPE AND CONTENT

Record Group 16 includes records of the short-lived, independent Game and Fish Department (1933-1935), in addition to those of the Game and Fish Conservation Commission. Since the Game and Fish Conservation Commission lasted only from 1935 to early 1937, the two groups of records have been processed together.

Correspondence of two State Wardens provides the bulk of the collection, which is embellished by informational material, reports, and various miscellaneous records. Copies of Board meeting minutes are found in the manual for Deputy Wardens.

During the period first efforts at controlling pollution and developing a restocking program were made; these endeavors are documented here.

An index of general correspondence follows the listings of that subseries. For further information on Game and Fish, see Record Groups 10, 15, and 17.
